Bradley Richardson is a research fish biologist with the USDA - Agricultural Research Service. He works in the Warmwater Aquaculture Research Unit (WARU) at Stoneville, MS. His research interests include species interactions, community ecology, and ecosystem resiliency.

For the past 10 years, Bradley has worked extensively in R and RStudio, providing formal and informal trainings to a variety of audiences. Trainings and workshops have included graduate, undergraduate, and high school students, postdocs, research associates, and scientists. He is often sought out to aid in data analysis and visualization by colleagues at WARU, as well as cooperating universities and other research units.

At WARU, Bradley's research primarily focuses on the catfish pond environment and how that relates to disease and management practices. Current research projects center on managing aquatic snails that serve as parasite vectors for catfish, which subsequently reduce production.
